***Little Episodes* comes over all queer for a celebration of the different**

Little Episodes, the organisation that promotes the arts as a therapeutic tool and platform to incite empathy and understanding, is hosting 'Queer Episodes' at The Red Room, underneath Positively 4th Street, on Thursday 25 November 2010.

'Queer Episodes' will see the opening of the call for submissions for the latest anthology by *Little Episodes*, 'Queer Episodes - celebrating the different'. Co-edited by American writer and performer, Clint Catalyst and *Little Episodes* founder Lucie Barât, it will be an anthology celebrating queer literature in all its unleashed glory.

'Queer Episodes - celebrating the different' is an exploration of loves gained, loves lost, loves shared, coming out, staying out, how the world looks from a queer eye and how the world looks at you. The anthology is already expected to have contributions from Stella Duffy and Lou Wakefield.

In addition to the call for submissions, 'Queer Episodes' will host musician and songwriter, Alice Temple, acclaimed writers Alec Bell and Marc Walden and many more, for an evening of queer music and poetry. There will also be limited open mic slots available for people who wish to perform.

Lucie Barât, founder of *Little Episodes*, said: "This event and the subsequent anthology will be an expression of what it is to be an active member of the community today. 'Queer Episodes' is about channelling experience to influence your art and this event and the anthology that will follow, will give light to a too often neglected genre.

"Everybody has a story to tell and as we enter these austere times, it is for the artists to step forward, create, submit and work together to create their own platforms."
